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## Parents Session

This session seeks to educate and inform parents about gangs, gang culture and the GAV programme. Parents are given an overview of our evidence-based curriculum and receive an academic and policing perspective into serious youth violence including the "push" and "pull" factors that account for gang associations. Gang recruitment processes and the roles and risks to girls involved in gang culture are identified. Parents are made aware of the warning signs of gang membership and advised on appropriate interventions.
